



ROTARY CLUB OF SOUTH WAIRARAPA
Taratahi Agricultural Training Centre Bursary

- The bursary shall be known as the Rotary Club of South Wairarapa Taratahi Agricultural Training Centre Bursary and shall be for the amount equal to the fees for one full year of study.
- The trustees of the bursary will be the President, Immediate Past President, Martinborough Fair Chairperson, and the Youth Director.
- The bursary shall be awarded to candidates who are permanent residents of the South Wairarapa Rotary District. (*Permanent residency shall be defined by the Electoral Act.*)
- Advertisements for candidates to apply for the bursary will be placed by Taratahi Agricultural Training Centre concurrent with advertising of the courses the Centre has available.
- The Selection Committee shall consist of:
 - The President of the Rotary Club of South Wairarapa or nominee thereof
 - The Director, Vocational and Youth Committee, Rotary Club of South Wairarapa
 - Two representatives of the Training Centre, to be selected by the Board of Trustees
- The Bursary may be awarded for a full year course, currently \$2,940
- A part year course, a pro-rata allocation of \$2,940 for the relevant number of weeks in the academic year. More than one bursary may be awarded if part-year courses are chosen, but the total amount so awarded in any one year may not be more than \$2,940 in total
- If no suitable candidate is found the Selection Committee shall not be bound to award a bursary or bursaries.
- The award is a bursary, not a scholarship. The student nominated should be academically capable of attaining the qualification being sought. The criteria for consideration of each applicant involves assessment of their academic ability, work habits, personality, temperament, general interests and the financial situation of their family.
- The bursary may be held concurrently with any other bursary or scholarship provided that the rules of the other award(s) permit this.
- The bursary will be paid when the recipient forwards a copy of their enrolment documentation to the Secretary of the Rotary Club of South Wairarapa. Payment will be made direct to the Taratahi Agricultural Training Centre on behalf of the recipient.
- The recipient of the bursary is required to give a personal report to the Rotary Club on progress and achievements. The Rotary Club will publicise the award of the Bursary to the recipient.
- The bursary shall be a designated fund and voluntary repayments of bursaries, donations to the capital fund, bequests etc. shall be accepted providing they do not alter the intent of the specified
