Criteria for Funding Applications

OBJECTIVES

- To foster the betterment and enjoyment of residents of the South Wairarapa district.
- To benefit as many as possible within the South Wairarapa community.
- To enhance the profile of South Wairarapa Rotary.
- To support projects that are in harmony with Rotary programmes and objectives for the community.

GUIDELINES

- Our preference is for the purchase of capital items or to maintain capital
- Funds are not normally provided for wages or for operating costs.
- Rotary does not normally offer personal relief from hardship.
- We do not fund individual courses of study apart from bursaries.
- Pledges are only paid when the balance of funds has been raised.
- Every endeavour is be made to be consistent when considering applications.
- We do not normally fund projects which are the province of national or local government or Government agencies.
- We consider the stability of the applying organisation
- We consider if the benefit to the community is short or long-term

RECIPIENTS

- Organisations which offer services to the residents of the South Wairarapa.
- Generally, these organisations will have a base in the South Wairarapa.
- However, a South Wairarapa base is NOT a pre-requisite for consideration where the benefit is for the people of the South Wairarapa but available only elsewhere eg Starship Hospital, Te Omanga Hospice, Otaki Health Camp, Child Cancer, Margaret Stewart House. (e.g. Plunket car seats have been recipients.)
